



Cindy's Jumpers Margarita Machine Rental Operating Instructions

INSTALLATION

1. Place the Margarita cart in a prominent leveled location.

NOTE:

Do not remove the Margarita Machine from the heavy duty card in which it came in. These machines are very heavy and may damage any other table.

2. Plug the power cord into a suitable dedicated (20 amp) 120 volt outlet that can provide the required wattage. Having other appliances on the same circuit, may prevent your unit from receiving the necessary voltage and will not work.
3. Once the machine is connected. Turn the power button to the ON position. The power button is located on the top left corner of the digital display box.

GENERAL OPERATING PROCEDURES

1. Add 2 gallons of water to each bowl. Then add one ½ gallon bottle of mix.

NOTE:

Make sure that both sides are on the “Auger ON” position and “ICE” settings. If you leave it on the “CHILL” position the machine will never freeze the drink and only chill it.

2. Let the mix freeze. Average freeze time is 1 hour indoors and 2 hours outdoors. Make sure that the machine is in the shade and **NOT** in direct sunlight.
3. Once the mix is frozen. Then you add one bottle of 1.75 liters of alcohol per bowl.

NOTE:

To cut down on freezing time, put your alcohol bottles in the freezer the night before and put your water in the fridge. This will cut down on your freeze time. It's always better to start with 32 degree cold alcohol than 80 degree hot alcohol.

4. If you add the alcohol before the mix it frozen the machine could take up to 4 hours to freeze.
5. The driver can start your first batch. Just remember, to add the alcohol after the mix is frozen.
6. Each bowl will make about 80 – 10oz drinks. Enjoy!

CLEANING

No Cleaning is required just empty out all the extra mix and run cold water through the margarita machine.
